

## Junior Summer Courses in Chichester

Chichester is a small city in the South of England, approximately half-way between Portsmouth and Brighton, and just a 2 hour drive from London.

The city also has the advantage of being close to the wonderful beaches in Bognor Regis and West Wittering. Chichester was built on the foundations of an ancient Roman-British city, with many of its medieval city walls still in place. The streets still have their cross-shaped layout, leading outwards from the famous medieval market to the North, South, East and West shopping streets. Along these streets you can find marvellous little shops and cafés.



### Campus: Bishop Otter Campus (University of Chichester)

- Placement test on arrival
- Certificate at the end of the course
- Supervised activity programme every afternoon and evening: in the afternoon students can choose between several activities available.
