Campus: Trinity School

Our summer school is based in the private Trinity School. Trinity School is an attractive campus overlooking the sea and is just a 15 minute walk from the town centre.



Campus facilities

- Light and spacious classrooms

What's included?

- Full-board residential accommodation in multi-bedded standard rooms (1-4 students) in Trinity School
- Full-board accommodation in twin or triple rooms with one of our local home stay hosts with packed lunches (minimum age 12 years)
- English language tuition (15 or 20 lessons per week, 45 minutes each) in mixed nationality classes where possible
- Maximum 15 students per class
- Course material
- Placement test on arrival
- Certificate at the end of the course
- Supervised activity programme every afternoon and evening: in the afternoon students can choose between several available activities.
- 2 half-day trips and one full-day trip per fortnight
- One half-day trip and one full-day trip for every additional week
- Use of campus facilities
- Supervision by our International Team
